- 01 **Summer Outreach Programs**
As a KYUEM alumnus, I leveraged my network with the University Relations Department to initiate a collaboration between the college and ICUMS, to host mock interviews and summer outreach programs to provide more tailored support for students aspiring to Imperial. Moving forward, I also aim to broaden this initiative to other leading pre-university colleges, like Taylor's, Sunway, and KTJ.
- 02 **New Sponsorship Tier**
We need real-life industrial exposure and startups require young talents and ideas. I say we introduce a new category to our sponsorship tiers called internship partners, targeting STEM based startups in Malaysia.
