1. Reconstruction of Committee, Bringing Active Effort

Reconstructing a student society committee is essential for improving efficiency, continuity, and long-term development. For a rapidly evolving AI society, restructuring should prioritise individuals who consistently demonstrate engagement and commitment. This may include integrating Imperial alumni and highly active non-Imperial contributors to replace inactive principal roles, forming a more reliable and comprehensive team capable of supporting the society's operational needs.

This matter is important because a reconstructed committee must address existing gaps while establishing a culture of accountability and sustained contribution. Involving active individuals—regardless of background—can strengthen organisational capacity and broaden strategic direction. Careful discussion of this approach is necessary to ensure the society develops in a structured and purposeful manner.

2. Not Enough Active Attendance Despite Numerous Applications

Low active attendance, despite high application numbers, presents a significant challenge. Strong initial interest suggests potential for engagement, yet low participation often reflects unclear expectations, insufficient communication, or limited involvement opportunities. This weakens community cohesion, reduces event effectiveness, and restricts the diversity of perspectives essential for a dynamic society.

Consistent participation is crucial for maintaining momentum, supporting collaborative projects, and ensuring initiatives reach their intended audience. When attendance is inconsistent, the society struggles to justify resource use, secure sponsorship, or demonstrate impact. Addressing this requires clearer onboarding, improved communication, and activities that encourage sustained involvement.

3. Communication Issues with Other Top Universities

Effective communication with leading universities is vital for organising joint events, sharing insights, and hosting collaborative hackathons. Weak or inconsistent communication limits opportunities for inter-university engagement and reduces exposure to broader academic and professional networks.

This issue is particularly important for an AI-focused society, where innovation depends on collaboration and knowledge exchange. Establishing reliable communication channels enables participation in larger initiatives, access to best practices, and contribution to a wider academic community. Strengthening these connections is essential for supporting growth and ensuring members benefit from a rich, interconnected environment.
